The after part of the stern post, or if the vessel without a stern port, forepart of the rudder stock “Breadth” means extreme breadth on feet or meters not counting rubbers “Depth” mean the height in feet of meters of mid ship section of the top deck beam in the meddle line above the top of the keel.

Where the gross tonnage is not accurately known it will be determined by:
